NOTES/MINUTES

1. Opening remarks from interim/outgoing President Sydney Kasner: Sydney convened the meeting at approximately 1210pm. Approximately 60 attendees were logged in, including some students.
2. Installation of new officers: Barbara Smith conducted the swearing in ceremony for new officers as follows: President Abbie Berman, President-elect Matt McLinden, Vice President Ashley Willner, and Secretary/Treasurer Sydney Kasner. Nominations and voting was held remotely in advance in accordance with our bylaws.
3. Budget review: 2022-23 budget approved by the board was shared onscreen and reviewed for members who were present.
4. Bylaws: Updated bylaws were voted on and approved by members present. Bylaws revisions had been shared to members on 2/25/2022, more than a month in advance of this meeting in accordance with our bylaws. No objections or questions were posed. Updated bylaws document to be posted to our website ASAP.
5. 2022-23 board meetings: Board meetings scheduled for May 7 2022, June 11 2022, Oct 15 2022, Jan 21 2023, and April 2023 dates were announced. More info about locations and agendas to come on website as soon as available.
6. Additional events: Sydney announced/reminded about upcoming events later this year - the SLDP (Student Leadership Development Program) for this year and new selection for 2023 later this fall (ASRT to select Oregon awardees), Mammography CE conference rescheduled from May to October 2022, and the next Annual Meeting in person likely at the coast in 2023, pending post survey results from this meeting. Reminder that Diamond Lake event is cancelled due to multiple reasons - fires, snow, not enough bandwidth or demand.
7. Year in review: Sydney highlighted the many accomplishments and achievements of our board and our society members over the past year, in spite of the myriad challenges presented by Covid. These included a fun and exciting Rad Tech week, active advocacy work by OSRT board at the OBMI and state legislature, keeping our CE offerings strong including a cultural competency self-study course to meet the new state requirement, student scholarships, and an updated multi-year strategic plan. We also introduced our new hire and only paid employee to attendees - welcome to Andrea Adamson as our new Executive Administrator!
8. Raffles: We raffled off free CEs and a 1 year free ASRT membership, and also lots of OSRT swag procured by Matt - magnets, keychains, stickers. Also a beautiful photograph printed on metal was raffled off. All items will be shipped out following meeting conclusion.
